
Sunday of the Word of God

Getting to Know Mark – The Gospel of Mark is the <u>briefest in length</u> of the four Gospels and most likely the first that was written.

Most scholars agree that Mark wrote his account <u>shortly</u> <u>before 70 A.D. in Rome</u>, at a time of pending persecution, and when the destruction of Jerusalem was imminent. The Gospel's detailed and vivid descriptions of the ministry of Jesus offer insights not provided by Matthew or Luke. <u>Mark's message is powerful, stark, and direct.</u> We are invited and challenged to accept Jesus Christ as our Lord and Saviour.

<u>The Winged Lion</u> – Early Christians used creatures as symbols of the four Gospels. Saint Mark is symbolized as the winged lion. An angel, represented by a winged lion, appeared to Mark in a dream exclaiming, "Peace to you Mark my Evangelist, here will rest your body."
