Vincentian Meditation:

"There are scripture scholars who say that there is a very subtle twist to the end of the parable. Jesus asks the lawyer: "Which of these three, in your opinion, was neighbour to the man who fell in with robbers?" The answer came, "The one who treated him with mercy." It would seem that in asking the lawyer that question, Jesus was saying equivalently to him, "You asked Me 'who was my neighbour?' That was not a good question. The question you should have asked me was: "To whom can I BE neighbour? And the answer to that question is, 'the first poor person you meet on the road.'" (McCullen, Deep Down Things, p. 141)
