Jubilee 2025 - New Year's Resolutions

The purpose of a Jubilee year is to intensify our experience of God's grace (Divine life) within and around us. We might cooperate with that ever-present grace, to have that renewal in the Church.

Here we present some suggestions that you might include in your resolutions:

<u>Rediscover the Hope in the Sacrament of Penance:</u> How can I improve my preparation for the Sacrament of reconciliation? Can I include a monthly visit with Christ in the confessional?

<u>Frame each day with daily prayer:</u> How can I improve my morning and my evening prayer?

<u>Make a regular Holy Hour:</u> At St. Joseph we offer Adoration every First Friday, but the church is open during office hours. Can I spend more time with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament?

Give the tithe of your time to God: Can I schedule daily time in silence to listen what God wants to tell me? Deepen our lives into the Gospel: How can I practice the works of mercy? How do I incorporate a bigger understanding of the Ten Commandments and the Beatitudes?

To have a real renewal, we need to focus our attention in Christ. He must be the centre of our lives, and we must follow the footprints of the Teacher.

Support for your Marriage – Does your marriage feel like it is more trouble than joy, does it feel stagnant or disconnected? Is it causing you constant stress? The solution is Retrouvaille – whose one purpose is to help couples restore their marriage and rebuild a loving relationship. This is a practical program, where sharing is not required except between the couple themselves. It is designed to improve communication, build stronger marriages, and help couples reconnect. For struggling couples, including those who may be considering separation or divorce. The next Retrouvaille weekend is March 7-9, 2025. 
